Malone of LaCanada, California, Ethel Malone of Idyllwild, California and Margaret King of Minneapolis, Minnesota, owners of the following described property: All of Section Twenty-one (21), Township One Hundred Four (104) North, Range Thirty-four (34) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Jackson County, Minnesota, grantees, witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable consideration in hand paid to the grantors by the grantees, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said grantors hereby grant, bargain. sell and convey, to the grantees, their heirs and assigns forever, a right of way and easement in, on, along,
