- Property Tax Refund If your taxes exceed certain income-based thresholds, and your total household income is less than \$135,410.
- Special Property Tax Refund If you also owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2023, and **both** of the following are true:

- The net property tax on your homestead increased by more than 12% from 2023 to 2024.
- The increase was at least \$100, not due to improvements on the property.

Penalty For Late Payment Of Property Tax

If you pay your first half or second half property tax after the due dates, a penalty will be added to your tax. The later you pay, the greater the penalty you must pay. The table below shows the penalty amounts added to your tax if your property taxes are not paid

Note to manufactured homeowners: The title to your manufactured home cannot be transferred unless all

current year and delinquent personal property taxes are paid at the time of transfer.

SENIOR CITIZENS' PROPERTY TAX DEFERRAL

The Senior Citizens' Property Tax Deferral Program provides a low-interest loan to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program:

• Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and

- Ensures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program. To be eligible, you must file an application by November 1, 2024, as well as:
 - 1. Be at least 65 years old,
 - 2. Have a household income of \$96,000 or less, and
 - 3. Have lived in your home for at least 5 years.
